Call for Nominations

The Chinese Economic Association (UK) calls for nominations of board directors. We aim at recruiting two board directors at our annual general meeting in Oxford on 12 July. Four candidates are required for the election procedure. Candidates should hold a PhD degree preferably in economics or business. A candidate should be recommended by any two members of the Association in writing to the board. Supporting documents include a full CV and a short bio of the candidate, a statement in which the candidate explains why he/she is interested in the position and what are to be accomplished during his/her term, and a letter of recommendation from those who initiate the candidacy. Candidates should be normally stationed in Europe and readily available for board meetings in the UK on annual basis.

The CEA (UK) nomination committee will be responsible for the procedure of the nomination process and for the selection of the four candidates who will be passed on to the annual general meeting for the ballot. The nomination committee consists of the board directors as follows:
